Canadian Screen Award-nominated producer Mark Bradley has worked in the television industry for over 27 years. He has produced award-winning broadcast television series and one-off arts and nature documentaries for major Canadian broadcasters, including documentary Channel, APTN, Oasis, VisionTV, Knowledge, and Citytv. Projects have included the Gemini Award-winning *Landscape as Muse*, *Grasslands*, *Great Minds of Design*, *The Nature of Inspiration*, and Leo Award-winning series *Visionary Gardeners*. He has been nominated for five Leo Awards as producer and two as editor. He has been nominated for three Canadian Screen Awards, including a 2024 nomination for *Ageless Gardens* (Rob Stewart Award for Best Science or Nature Documentary Program or Series).
